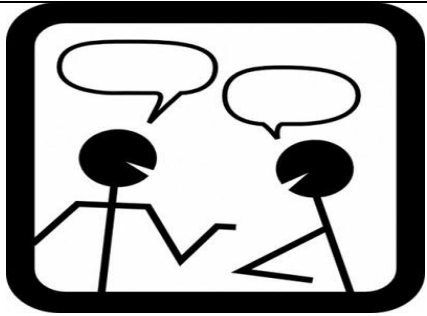


Privacy to Privacy
